

NIT-Tiruchy lone non-IIT institution in top 10 list, ranked ninth

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THE National Institute of Technology -Tiruchy (NIT-T) retained its 9th position among top engineering colleges in the country. The latest NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework) rankings show NIT-Tiruchy improving the institutional standing to 30th overall.

According to the latest NIRF rankings, NIT Tiruchy has improved its overall institutional ranking from 31st to 30th this year. It has also retained its 9th position among the top engineering institutions in India, making it the only non-IIT institution to feature in the top 10 of the engineering category. NIT Tiruchy has consistently maintained this top status among NITs for the past decade, making it 10 years in a row as the country's leading technical institute under NIT system.

The institute's Department of Architecture and Department of Management have also achieved commendable posi-



spectively. Dr Aghila, Director of NIT Tiruchy, said that the institute's continued success was the result of the hard work and dedicated efforts of its faculty, students, alumni, and staff.

Meanwhile, under the Universities category, Bharathidasan University (BDU) secured the 36th position with a score of 55.85. In the Arts and Science, Colleges category, St Joseph's College, Tiruchy, ranked 25th with a score of 66.59, followed by Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan College of Arts and Science for Women, Perambalur (40th rank), Bishop Heber College, Tiruchy (46th rank), Holy Cross College, Tiruchy (52nd rank), Rajah Serfoji Government College, Thanjavur (79th rank), and Jamal Mohammed College, Tiruchy (84th rank).

In management category, Indian Institute of Management - Tiruchy (IIM-T) was placed in the 16th spot, with a score 64.95.

The institute got 27th rank in 2024. Bharathidasan Institute of Management Tiruchy slipped to 96th rank from 94th rank last

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
