



IIM Tiruchirappalli Inaugurated Medical Centre in their Campus

IIM Tiruchirappalli inaugurated its campus **Medical Centre on 23rd November 2020** in the presence of Institute dignitaries, Kauvery Hospital representatives, and students on campus. The 24 x 7 functioning Medical Centre will provide emergency first aid and basic primary care to all the students, faculty, and staff members of IIM Tiruchirappalli.

The inauguration event began with the ribbon-cutting of the facility by the **Director (i/c)** of IIM Tiruchirappalli, **Prof. Godwin Tennyson**. Introducing the medical centre facilities to all those who present, he spoke about how the concept of this centre was developed for the students, faculty members, staff, and their families in campus. Detailing the effort that went into setting up the Medical Centre, he elaborated the whole journey and lauded the efforts of all administrative staff members who were involved in the project for completing it within the decided timeframe. Prof. Godwin also introduced the team from Kauvery Hospital who had come for inauguration.

Prof. Prashant Gupta, Chief Administrative Officer (i/c) spoke in detail about the amenities of the Institute Medical Centre that includes:

- Doctor's Consultation from 10.00 a.m to 7.00 p.m on all days, including Sundays.
- Availability of Staff Nurses on a 24 x 7 basis
- Medical equipment like ECG Machine, Defibrillator with External Paddles AED mode, Multi Para Monitor, etc
- Two beds for patient observation.
- Ambulance service based on the recommendations of the Doctor

Talking about the hard work that went into the procurement of equipment and supplies especially amid the pandemic situation, he congratulated all the associated staff members for turning the project into reality.

The event was conducted maintaining proper safety protocols and social distancing.
