IIM Trichy Celebrates its Tenth Foundation Day

IIM Tiruchirappalli (IIM Trichy) celebrated its 10th Foundation Day on 4th January 2021. The day marks a decade since its inception as the 11th Indian Institute of Management of the country. Faculty, staff, and students on campus attended the event in person and virtually, and many others associated with the institute such as its former and current Chairmans, former Directors, Board members, current students, and alumni attended the celebration virtually as the institute webcast the event live.

The event was inaugurated with an invocation song and the lighting of the lamp by Dr. Godwin Tennyson, Director (i/c) & Dean (Administration), Prof. Deepak Kumar Srivastava, Dean (Academics), Prof. V. Gopal, Chairperson, Make a Difference (MAD) Project Coordination Team and Prof. S. Sivakumar, Chairperson, Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGPM). The Chief Guest, Shri M. Damodaran, IAS (Retd.) and founding Chairman of IIM Trichy and Shri. Jalaj Dani, Chairman, Board of Governors, IIM Trichy, joined the event online.
