IIM Tiruchirappalli Strengthens Industry-Academia Collaboration with Strategic Partnerships in July 2025

MoUs signed with Renault Nissan Automotive India Pvt. Ltd. and Hyundai Motor India Limited.

Tiruchirappalli, July 2025 — The Indian Institute of Management Tiruchirappalli (IIM Trichy) has taken significant strides in deepening its industry-academia engagements by signing two key Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) during July 2025.
