Dr. Sarangapani said Emotional Intelligence is measured by 'Emotional Quotient' (EQ). He even speculated a formula to measure Intelligent Quotient (IQ) = (Mental age or Maturity

age/Calendar age) x 100 and shared the ratio for success in the proportion of EQ:IQ = 80:20. Brain can be made into 3 main parts: Logic + Emotion + Instinct and emotion process is 6000 times faster than cognitive process. He insisted on 5 main elements to reach success: Self-awareness, Self-regulation, Motivation, Empathy and Interpersonal skill.
