OBJECTIVES:

The aim of this NFLP is that the participants (teachers/ faculty) will be able to gain an understanding of the academic leadership requirements across multiple domains-

- Crafting an ecosystem for academic excellence through vision, mission, and strategy and stakeholder management for effective organizations.
- Managing functional facets such as financial aspects and intellectual property rights aspects, positioning the institution brand for national and international markets, and enhancing research and publication capabilities.
- Honing soft skills such as leadership, communication, influencing, negotiation, emotional intelligence, stress management, and team dynamics.
- Handling the student interface through mentoring and counseling students and advancing pedagogical interventions in sync with emerging technologies.

PEDAGOGY:

The pedagogy of the program will be predominantly an experiential learning process. The methodology will be highly interactive, incorporating the following pedagogical tools and techniques:

- Case studies
- Roleplays
- Individual and Group activities
- Exercises encouraging reflection with self and peers
- Capstone project

The following outcomes are envisaged upon successful completion of the NFLP:

- Improvement in the team management, communication skills, and critical thinking of participants
- Dissemination of learnings from the programme to encourage other institutions to organize similar development programmes for their faculty
- Creation of a pool of trained institutional leaders
- Improvement in the administration of higher education institutions
