Response: At IIM Tiruchirappalli, the approved academic intake has increased from 390 seats in the academic year 2024 to 460 seats in the academic year 2025.

Response: (i) IIM Tiruchirappalli currently partnership with 16 Business Schools/ Universities from where students visit the campus as part of Students exchange.

(iii) IIM Tiruchirappalli desires to set up a campus abroad in the future after careful study of the location, requirement and viability.

(a) The impact of closing of schools, colleges, universities, and other educational institutions for six months on the students, due to Covid19 pandemic.

The impact on IIM, Tiruchirappalli students is very minimal as we started online classes in August, 2020 for both 2nd year students and the incoming batch of 1st year students. The only impact is we are currently running about 1 month behind schedule in our usual academic calendar and we are trying to make up for this delay in the upcoming terms.

(b) The extent to which online classes are successful.

The formal end-of-course feedback is yet to be obtained for either Term-IV or Term-I courses. 

- A: 1. An induction programme is arranged before the beginning of the first term of the PGP.
2. An Orientation Programme is arranged as soon as all the selected students register for the programme in the beginning of first term of PGP. This Orientation Programme acquaints them with the academic, socio-economic environment of the institute as well as the city of Tiruchirappalli. This also helps as an ice-breaker and enables them to cope up with the new challenges that they are going to face in their academic pursuit over the next two years.
3. Tutorials are conducted by a group of students of second year under the close supervision and guidance of the faculty members in subjects like Financial Accounting, Quantitative Techniques and Operations Management to give additional inputs and coaching over and above the teaching in the class to the students who are weak in these subjects.
4. Faculty Counsellors have been appointed to counsel the students to help them cope up with the academic rigour and the stress, if any, that it generates.
5. A number of guest faculty from the industry is invited to talk to the students so that students can get practical orientation to supplement the theoretical discussions in the class.
6. Students are encouraged to work on "live projects" which gives them a hands-on experience to see how the theoretical concepts that they study in their class are practiced and implemented in real life.
7. A number of case studies are discussed as a part of course curriculum.
8. The library acts as a LRC (Learning Resource Centre), houses all the major magazines, periodicals and research journals from all over the world along with a number of reference books on each subject.
9. A Language Corner has been established to help our students to enhance their language and communication skills. This corner strengthen their skills in three languages. They are also taught French and German languages as per their aptitude and interest.
10. International Student Exchange Programme - In order to make the students aware of the global diversity and expand their horizons, students are encouraged to go on an exchange programme with one of the partnering institutions abroad every year. This exchange programme not only exposes them to the socio-cultural diversity that exists in the world but also gives them an opportunity to interact and network with students and faculty members from different countries. This broadens their mind and makes them more tolerant to the diversity.
11. We encourage students to get additional certifications in six sigma (for example) which adds to their qualifications as well as certifies their knowledge by independent outside organisations/institutions.
